# Pearce Receives Endorsement of Western Missouri Shooters Alliance

BELTON \_ In another example of 31<sup>st</sup> State Senate District Candidate David Pearce's commitment to our Second Amendment rights, the Western Missouri Shooters Alliance has endorsed Pearce in the general election.

The Western Missouri Shooters Alliance was created to inform concerned Missouri citizens about legislation that affects their rights as it relates to the Constitution and our Second Amendment rights to bear arms. The group is involved in efforts to educate the public and promote freedom as the Founding Fathers intended.

“David understands the true meaning of the Second Amendment as it was written by the founders in the Bill of Rights,” said Sheila Stokes-Begley, President of the Western Missouri Shooters Alliance. “As our next State Senator, we look forward to future legislation that David will sponsor to protect the Second Amendment and citizens of Missouri.”

“I am extremely pleased to receive the support of the Western Missouri Shooters Alliance and pledge to continue supporting the rights of sportsman and law-abiding Missourians to keep and bear arms under the Second Amendment,” Pearce said.

The endorsement is the second from a major Second Amendment group for Pearce, whose efforts in the Legislature on behalf of sportsman and law-abiding citizens earned him the National Rifle Association endorsement in June.

Pearce is an ardent supporter of the Second Amendment and hunting rights in the Missouri Legislature. David also passed the “Katrina Bill” which prevents state and municipal governments in Missouri from confiscating legally owned firearms in a state of emergency.
